(STATION BRAE, HILLSIDE PLACE AND
CUPAR ROAD, NEWPORT ON TAY)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019

On 14/08/2019 Fife Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is as stated in the issue of the Courier published on 20/02/2019.

A copy of the Order, which is operational from 01/09/2019 and a drawing showing the affected roads, may be inspected, without payment of fee, during normal office hours at Fife Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and via public access pc's at your closest library. The documents will also be available online at www.fifedirect.org.uk/notices. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from 14/08/2019 apply to the Court of Session for the purpose.
