

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (CITY FIBRE 11, REGENT WALK AND ORCHARD STREET, ABERDEEN)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the order is to impose a temporary prohibition of driving on Regent Walk between its junction with King Street and the boundary between the rear of No 560 King Street and 1 Regent Walk. An alternative route is available via King Street, Seaton Roundabout, School Road and Golf Road. There will also be a prohibition of waiting on the south side of the same street from 08:00 until 17:00 on 12 April, 2021. Access to properties will be maintained, but no through traffic will be possible. There will also be a prohibition of waiting on the north side of Orchard Street between its junction with Spital and opposite the boundary between No's 61 & 63 Orchard Street from 08:00 on 13 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 15 April, 2021.

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (CITY FIBRE PN216, ROSEMOUNT, ABERDEEN)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order is to impose a temporary prohibition of driving on Thomson Street Lane, Aberdeen, between its junction with Rosemount Place and a point 10 metres in a northerly direction from 08:00 on 15 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 16 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Rosemount Place, Thomson Street and Loanhead Place. Access to properties will be maintained, but no through traffic will be possible. There will also be a temporary one-way restriction on Watson Street, Aberdeen, between its junctions with Westburn Road and Rosemount Place from 08:00 on 20 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 22 April, 2021. The permitted direction of travel will be southbound only. An alternative route for northbound vehicles is available via Rosemount Place and Loanhead Terrace.

There will also be a prohibition of waiting on either side on the following streets between 08:00 and 17:00 Mon-Sat; Loanhead Place, Rosemount Place, Thomson Street, Thomson Street Lane, Wallfield Crescent, Wallfield Place, Watson Street, Westburn Road, Aberdeen from 08:00 on 15 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 26 May, 2021.

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (CITY FIBRE PN276, MASTRICK, ABERDEEN)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order is to impose a temporary prohibition of driving on the following streets: Corndavon Terrace, Aberdeen, between its junction with Derry Place and the gable end of number 52 Corndavon Terrace from 08:00 on 14 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 15 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Derry Place, Cairnwell Drive and Derry Avenue; Derry Place, Aberdeen, between its junction with Corndavon Terrace and the gable end of number 12 Derry Place from 08:00 on 20 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 21 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Corndavon Terrace, Derry Avenue and Cairnwell Drive; Derry Place, Aberdeen, between its junctions with Corndavon Terrace and Mastrick Road from 08:00 on 22 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 23 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Mastrick Road, Derry Avenue and Cairnwell Drive; Ross Crescent, Aberdeen, between its junction with Mastrick Road and a point 10 metres in a southerly direction from 08:00 on 24 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 25 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Mastrick Road, Arnage Place and Arnage Drive; Derry Avenue, Aberdeen, between its junction with Corndavon Terrace and the gable end of number 9 Derry Avenue from 08:00 on 26 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 27 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Mastrick Road, Derry Place and Corndavon Terrace; Corndavon Terrace, Aberdeen, between its junction with Derry Avenue and the gable end of number 34 Corndavon Terrace from 08:00 on 28 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 29 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Derry Avenue, Cairnwell Drive and Derry Place; Arnage Place, Aberdeen, between its junction with Mastrick Road and a point 10 metres in a southerly direction from 08:00 on 4 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 5 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Mastrick Road, Ross Crescent and Arnage Drive. Access to properties will be maintained, but no through traffic will be possible.

There will also be a prohibition of waiting on either side on the following streets between 08:00 and 17:00 Mon-Sat; Arnage Place, Arnage Terrace, Corndavon Terrace, Derry Avenue, Derry Place, Mastrick Road, Aberdeen from 08:00 on 14 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 25 May, 2021.

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (CITY FIBRE PN276, MASTRICK, ABERDEEN)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)(NUMBER 2) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order is to impose a temporary prohibition of driving on the following streets:

Cairnwell Drive, Aberdeen, between its junction with Derry Avenue and the gable end of number 37 Cairnwell Drive from 08:00 on 16 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 17 April, 2021. An alternative route is available via Gairnshiel Avenue, Invercauld Road and Craigmaddoch Avenue; Cairnwell Drive, Aberdeen, between its junctions with Craigmaddoch Avenue and Craigmaddoch Place from 08:00 on 4 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 5 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Craigmaddoch Avenue, Invercauld Road and Craigmaddoch Place; Craigmaddoch Avenue, Aberdeen, between its junction with Cairnwell Drive and the gable end of number 9 Craigmaddoch Avenue from 08:00 on 6 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 7 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Cairnwell Drive, Craigmaddoch Place and Invercauld Road; Invercauld Road, Aberdeen, between its junctions with Craigmaddoch Avenue and the entrance to Kingswood Court from 08:00 on 8 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 9 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Craigmaddoch Avenue, Cairnwell Drive and Gairnshiel Avenue; Cairnwell Drive, Aberdeen, between its junctions with Derry Place and the entrance to garages between number 72 and 74 Cairnwell Drive from 08:00 on 10 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 11 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Derry Place, Mastrick Road, Mastrick Junction and Cairnwell Avenue; Craigmaddoch Place, Aberdeen, between its junction with Cairnwell Place and the boundary between number 7 and 9 Craigmaddoch Place from 08:00 on 12 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 13 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Cairnwell Place, Cairnwell Avenue and Cairnwell Drive; Craigmaddoch Avenue, Aberdeen, between its junction with Invercauld Gardens and the boundary between number 33 and 35 Craigmaddoch Avenue from 08:00 on 17 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 18 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Invercauld Road, Craigmaddoch Place and Cairnwell Drive; Gairnshiel Avenue, Aberdeen, between its junction with Invercauld Gardens and the gable end of number 13 Gairnshiel Avenue from 08:00 on 19 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 20 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Invercauld Gardens, Craigmaddoch Avenue and Invercauld Road; Invercauld Gardens, Aberdeen, between its junction with Craigmaddoch Avenue and the boundary between number 45 and 47 Invercauld Gardens from 08:00 on 21 May, 2021, until 17:00 on 22 May, 2021. An alternative route is available via Craigmaddoch Avenue, Cairnwell Drive and Gairnshiel Avenue. Access to properties will be maintained, but no through traffic will be possible.

There will also be a prohibition of waiting on either side on the following streets between 08:00 and 17:00 Mon-Sat Cairnwell Drive, Cairnwell Place, Craigmaddoch Avenue, Craigmaddoch Place, Derry Avenue, Gairnshiel Avenue, Invercauld Gardens, Invercauld Road, Aberdeen from 08:00 on 14 April, 2021, until 17:00 on 25 May, 2021.

The above orders have been made to protect public safety during duct laying works being carried out by City Fibre.

Due to any ongoing Covid-19 restrictions, the no-waiting restrictions will not be implemented for the full duration of the order and will only be implemented as and when required. The no-waiting restrictions will be demarcated by the use of no-waiting cones for no more than 50 metres at a time. Illegally parked vehicles will be removed at the owner's expense.

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the order, which will operate from 07:00 on Wednesday, 14 April 2021, until 17:00 on Tuesday, 20 April 2021, is to impose a temporary prohibition of driving on Cummings Park Crescent, Aberdeen, from the boundary between numbers 46-48 and 50-52 Cummings Park Crescent to the boundary between numbers 54-56 and 58-60 Cummings Park Crescent. There will also be a prohibition of waiting on either side of the same stretch of road. Access to properties will be maintained, but no through traffic will be possible. An alternative route is available via Granthill Road, Cummings Park Drive and Cummings Park Circle. The measures are necessary to protect public safety during water connection works. THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (DON STREET AREA, ABERDEEN) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the order, which will come into operation from 00:01 on 6 April 2021, until 23:59 on 30 March 2022, is to impose certain lengths of prohibition of waiting at any time on the roads listed in the first schedule. Exemptions will apply as usual to the picking up or setting down of passengers, loading or unloading, blue badge holders not causing an obstruction, funeral vehicles, and vehicles parked with the consent of the Council in direct association with authorised roadworks or building works. These measures are necessary to prevent indiscriminate parking, facilitate the safe moving of vehicles around Seaton Park and protect public safety.

First Schedule

Don Street

- South side, from its junction with King Street north-westwards then northwards then north-westwards for a distance of 670m or thereby.
- North side, from its junction with King Street north-westwards then northwards for a distance of 66m or thereby.
- East side from its junction with Lord Hays Road southwards for a distance of 10m or thereby.
- East side from its junction with Lord Hays Court northwards for a distance of 25m or thereby.
- East side from its junction with Lord Hays Grove southwards for a distance of 10m or thereby.
- East side from its junction with Lord Hays Grove northwards then north-westwards for a distance of 36m or thereby.
- East side from 10m south of the extended southern kerbline of the southern access into Hillhead Student Village north-westwards for a distance of 27m or thereby.

Lord Hays Road

- North side in its entirety.
- South side from its junction with Don Street eastwards for a distance of 10m.
- South side from 78m east of its junction with Don Street eastwards then northwards for a distance of 13m.

Lord Hays Grove

- South side in its entirety.
- North side from its junction with Don Street eastwards for a distance of 10m or thereby.
- North side from 31m east of its junction with Don Street eastwards then northwards for a distance of 14m or thereby.

Seaton Park – Unnamed Access Road

- Both sides from its junction with Don Street westwards to the off-street parking area.

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (GREAT WESTERN LANE, ABERDEEN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the order, which will operate from 07:00 on Thursday, 15 April 2021, until 17:00 on Tuesday, 27 April 2021, is to impose a temporary prohibition of driving on Great Western Lane, Aberdeen, from its junction with Hammersmith Road to the eastern boundary of the electricity sub-station. Access to properties will be maintained, but no through traffic will be possible. An alternative route is available via Gray Street, Great Western Road, and Hammersmith Road. The measure is necessary to protect public safety during works for Scottish and Southern Energy. THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (NORTH DEESIDE ROAD, SCHOOL ROAD, PETERCULTER, ABERDEEN)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2021

Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Aberdeen City Council has made the above-named order in terms of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order, which will operate from 00:01 on 4 January 2021, until 23:59 on 2 July 2023, is to impose traffic management restrictions on any of the roads as contained within the list of Adopted Highways within Aberdeen City.
