This roundtable will be focussed on workers from the oil and gas sector and invites you to discuss some of the most prominent issues and priorities, including (but not limited to):

- What are the best ways to measure if the transition is fair or not for workers?
- There has been lots of engagement on just transition, but there has been little action, what are the critical barriers and how can they be overcome?
- What more is needed from policy and from industry to support oil and gas workers to transition to new employment? What terms and conditions would workers need to see? What more is needed on the skills passport? What is the relative role of industry versus policy?
- How to best enable positive outcomes and develop positive concrete actions?
